



IOSH Safety for Senior Executives

Introduction

The course is designed to give Directors and Senior Managers a clear understanding of their responsibilities for health and safety at work, and practical guidance on how to improve health and safety performance. Using organisation or industry/sector specific examples (where available), it focuses on the moral, legal and economic reasons for effective safety management, and aims to influence Senior Executives' strategic thinking and their company's risk management systems.

Learning objectives

On successful completion, delegates should be able to:

- Understand the health and safety role and responsibilities of senior managers
- Recognise the importance of integrating health and safety objectives with other business objectives to minimise the overall risk to the organisation
- Take account of health and safety aspects during strategic planning, decision making and effective supply chain management
- Know the consequences of failing to manage health and safety effectively
- Understand the principles of occupational safety and health management systems, continual improvement and annual reporting

Format

This one day seminar is interactive, with the points illustrated by real life examples from the presenter's and the organisation's past experience. It is intended not only to motivate the senior decision makers in the organisation to pro-actively manage health and safety, but to give practical assistance in how to do so.

Delegates will be expected to take part in discussion and undertake exercises, including the development of a personal / organisation action plan.
